Elmbridge Borough Council - New Local Plan

Elmbridge Borough Council (EBC) draft Local Plan, which does not release any Green Belt, was submitted to the Planning Inspectorate on Thursday 10th August.

Village Green Application – One Tree Hill and Stokes Field Nature Reserve

Friday 21st July 2023 was the final day of the Village Green Public Inquiry, consisting of a site visit and legal summations from both sides. The Inspector's report will be published in a few months time. The report will go to Surrey County Council and will then be put before the SCC 'Planning and Regulatory Committee' for a decision. In the meantime, we wait.

Planning Applications

<u>Aldi Store</u> – The Aldi planning application (ref. 2021/3857) appeal was heard at a public inquiry. This is a divisive subject, as there are many residents both in favour and against. Aldi's appeal was rejected.
