### Who are we? What do we do?

The LDRA is non-political and non-religious. There is a committee comprised of elected officers and road representatives. We are ordinary residents, who have an interest and a willingness to get involved in issues affecting our village of Long Ditton.

Unlike other residents' associations, being non-political, the committee does not stand or endorse candidates in either Elmbridge Borough, or, Surrey County Council elections. As a result of this approach, we are able to act independently, in the interests of our residents, not having to 'toe the party line'.

The LDRA aims to preserve Long Ditton from over-development, maintain its character, improve its amenities and defend its surrounding Green Belt land.

We continue to defend our Green Belt from development, understanding its value for health & wellbeing, as well as the environmental and climatological benefits. We supported the 'Save HWLD Green Belt' team who, with residents support, achieved a superb victory with Village Green protected status for Stokes Field and One Tree Hill. We fully understand the need for housing and affordable homes, so support appropriate development which is sympathetic to the local area.

All our officers, co-opted members and road representatives are volunteers, giving their time freely. We are seeking new recruits who would like to become involved as members of the committee.
